This exhibit presents collaborative work produced by Katherine Liberovskaya and Al Margolis at the Experimental Television Center in Oswego, New York. The show includes *“Frogfields,”* a 15-minute experimental video controlled by audio via synthesizer based on footage of frogs at the Brooklyn Zoo, and *“Rantdance,”* a single channel video-audio piece based on the movements of a pair of cormorants filmed in Ghent, Belgium.
